



Not Otherwise Classified (NOC) Code Billing Guidelines

- All Current Procedural Terminology (CPT[®]) or Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) codes that are non-specific will be rejected as “unclean”. This includes most codes ending in 99 and others such as A4649, E1399, J3490 and J7799. If you feel these codes must be utilized for services delivered, you must submit supporting documentation as an attachment to your claim. National Drug Codes (NDC) codes are required for drugs.
- NOC codes will be paid at 20% of billed charges unless the health plan and care provider mutually agree to other payment terms before the service is rendered. Care providers should simply ask to negotiate a rate through the authorization intake process.
- All Durable Medical Equipment (DME) codes that are non-specific will require manufacturer’s invoice to determine pricing. Claims will be rejected as unclean claims if the invoice is not submitted.
