



Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System Care Provider Re-Enrollment

Certain care providers may receive a notice from Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS) to re-enroll as part of the Affordable Care Act and 42 CFR 455, Subpart E, and the provider registration process.

Re-enrollment means you'll complete the provider registration process and pay an enrollment fee. The enrollment fee and site visits only apply to certain providers types. The required re-enrollment forms will be listed on the notice you receive from AHCCCS, along with a link to the online forms.

What This Means For You

If you receive a re-enrollment notice please make sure to complete the process by the required date. If you don't, you can be terminated as an AHCCCS provider. This means UnitedHealthcare Community Plan won't be able to pay you for services to our UnitedHealthcare Community Plan members.
