



EPSDT Periodicity Schedule and Information

As a UnitedHealthcare network care provider, you're required to follow the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS) guidelines for well-child visits for members from birth through age 20. These guidelines state that you must include the services outlined in the Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) Periodicity Schedule as part of a comprehensive child health care program.

The EPSDT requirements outline a comprehensive child health care program that includes primary prevention, early intervention, diagnosis, medically necessary treatment and follow-up care of physical and behavioral health conditions.
