



KidsCare is back.

That means your patients who are UnitedHealthcare Community Plan members may qualify for low-cost health care.

Your patient might be eligible for health care. Open enrollment starts July 26, 2016.

Who is eligible?

- Arizona resident.
- 18 years and younger.
- Is a United States citizen or a qualified immigrant.
- Has a Social Security number or applies for one.
- Is not currently covered by other health insurance.
- Does not qualify for coverage through a state agency employee.
- Is not eligible to receive AHCCCS (Medicaid) coverage.
- Is a member of a household that is willing to pay a premium.
- Is under the income limit.

What are the income requirements?

| Family Size | Monthly Family Income | Annual Family Income |
|-------------|-----------------------|----------------------|
| 1 | \$1,980 | \$23,760 |
| 2 | \$2,670 | \$32,040 |
| 3 | \$3,360 | \$40,320 |
| 4 | \$4,050 | 48,600 |
| 5 | \$4,740 | \$56,880 |
| 6 | \$5,430 | \$65,160 |
