



Re: EAPG Payment Methodology Implementation for Hospitals and Ambulatory Surgical Centers

Soon, we'll reimburse eligible hospital outpatient and ambulatory surgical center (ASC) claims using Florida Medicaid's new outpatient payment method which uses Enhanced Ambulatory Patient Groups (EAPG) to calculate reimbursement. The Florida Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA) determines these rates.

What This Means for You

The effective date for the change will depend on the notification requirements in the facility's UnitedHealthcare Participation Agreement. We'll send each participating hospital and ambulatory surgical center a letter at the beginning of August with the start date of the facility's new EAPG pricing. The letter will also have more detail about the EAPG payment structure.
