



Adult Dental Services Now Covered, Effective Jan. 1, 2018

Beginning Jan. 1, 2018, UnitedHealthcare Community Plan will offer adult dental services to qualified members ages 21 and older.*

What You Need to Know

- The adult dental benefit includes the following services, up to a \$250 maximum annual benefit:
 - Oral Exams and cleanings twice a year
 - X-rays
 - Simple extractions**
