UnitedHealthcare's Specialty Pharmacy Program helps our members effectively manage rare or complex diseases and make the most of their benefits by giving them access to the right specialty medications, programs and support. Starting Dec. 19, 2016, the following specialty pharmacy medications will be added to UnitedHealthcare Community Plan of Michigan's Specialty Pharmacy program and will need to be filled by BrivoRx, OptumRx's Specialty Pharmacy:

- Apokyn
- Baraclude (entecavir)
- Cystagon
- Epivir HBV (lamivudine HBV)
- Hepsera (adefovir)
- Samsca
- Sandostatin (octreotide)
- Targretin capsule
- Targretin gel
- Thalomid (thalidomide)
- Tretinoin capsule
- Tyzeka (telbivudine)

UnitedHealthcare Community Plan of Michigan members who receive prescriptions through the Specialty Pharmacy Program have been notified of this change and may call 866-218-7398 to obtain their prescription. To help prevent any missed care opportunities, you may also call the specialty pharmacy on behalf of the member at 866-218-7398, but are not required to do so.

Our Specialty Pharmacy Program provides personalized support and resources to help members manage their condition, including:

- Information on their medication(s) and condition
- Eligibility for one-on-one support and counseling through our clinical management program
- 24/7 access to pharmacists to talk about their condition and medication therapy
- Speedy delivery and shipping in confidential, temperature-sensitive packaging (as required)
- Medication-related supplies, such as alcohol swabs and sharps container, are provided with each order as appropriate
- Refill reminders by phone and text at the member's request
