



Update to Diagnosis Codes for Body Mass Index (BMI) Documentation Provider Incentive

UnitedHealthcare Community Plan offers a care provider incentive payment for Body Mass Index (BMI) screenings and documentation. Care providers receive an annual \$10 payment for each UnitedHealthcare Community Plan member from ages 3 through 17 whose BMI is screened and documented.

Last October, ICD-9 coding transitioned to ICD-10 coding. UnitedHealthcare Community Plan primary care providers must use the following Body Mass Index Documentation Provider Incentive ICD-10 diagnosis codes to submit a claim and receive incentive payment.

1. CPT Category II Code 3008F - Body Mass Index Documented
The diagnosis code must be primary for CPT 3008F for this incentive.
2. One of the following evaluation and management services:
 - 99201-99205, Office/OP Visit
 - 99211-99215, Office/OP Visit
 - 99241-99245, Consult/OP Visit
 - 99382-99384, Initial preventative medicine/OP Visit
 - 99392-99394, Comp preventative medicine/OP Visit
 - 99401-99404, Preventative medical counseling/risk factor reduction
 - 99411-99412, Preventative medical counseling/risk factor reduction
3. One of the following ICD-10 diagnosis codes:
 - Z68.51 BMI, Pediatric < 5%
 - Z68.52 BMI, Pediatric 5% - < 85%
 - Z68.53 BMI, Pediatric 85% - < 95%
 - Z68.54 BMI, Pediatric > = 95%
