

**Pharmacy Vaccine and Immunization/Injection Billing Guidelines for
UnitedHealthcare Community Plan Members for 2017-2018**

UnitedHealthcare Community Plan’s pharmacy benefits manager, OptumRx, offers the vaccines listed in the following chart for UnitedHealthcare Community Plan members ages 21 and older in STAR and STAR+PLUS plans.

Use of National Drug Code (NDC)

When you bill vaccines and immunizations with dates of service from 2017 and in 2018, please use the correct National Drug Code (NDC) for the vaccine as published by Medi-Span® and listed below:

Claims and Billing

Claims need to have the following information:

- List the NDC and the Product/Service ID in Field 407-D7
- Enter “7” in the Submission Clarification Code Field 420-DK
 - Since the influenza vaccine is not in the Texas Medicaid formulary, “7” designates it as non-formulary, but medically necessary.
- Add “MA” for medication administration in DUR/PPS segment (Field section)
- Add the Professional Service code in the Field 440-E5

You don't have to be enrolled as a Medicaid provider with the Texas Medicaid & Healthcare Partnership. However, the Texas State Board of Pharmacy rules apply to your certification to provide immunizations and vaccinations. You do need to be contracted with the OptumRx network.

Administration Fee

Reimbursement rates include a \$10 administration fee in addition to the established retail contract rate fee when the vaccine is administered at the pharmacy.

Member Eligibility

You can verify member eligibility prior to administering the vaccination(s) online or by calling us:

- **Online:** To access the Eligibility and Benefits app, sign in to Link by clicking on the Link button in the top right corner of UHCprovider.com. Then select the Eligibility and Benefits app on your Link dashboard.
- **Phone:** Call Provider Services at **888-887-9003**, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.
