- 24/7 access to pharmacists to talk about their condition and medication therapy.
- Delivery and shipping in confidential, temperature-sensitive packaging (as required).
- Medication-related supplies, such as alcohol swabs and sharps container, are provided with each order as appropriate.
- Refill reminders by phone and text at the member's request.
