



Ambulatory Coding Claims Review Audit Begins Feb. 1

To help ensure claims accuracy, UnitedHealthcare Community Plan of Wisconsin is auditing enhanced ambulatory patient grouping (EAPG) claims beginning Feb. 1, 2016. New York County Health Services Review Organization (NYCHSRO)/MedReview, a health care review and auditing contractor, will conduct the review on our behalf and may contact you requesting medical records associated with these EAPG claims.

The audit will review EAPG claims submitted on or after Oct. 1, 2015 for appropriate Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) and Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) codes, modifiers and sequencing, along with assigned APGs, ambulatory payment classifications or ambulatory surgery centers.

If the audit determines the medical record does not support the submitted claim, you will be notified in a letter of the determination to change the claim payment based on the audit determination. If you do not supply the requested documentation to NYCHSRO/MedReview during the audit, your reimbursement amount for any reviewed claims may be adjusted.
