1. Background:

Lysteda is indicated for the treatment of cyclic heavy menstrual bleeding.

2. Coverage Criteria:

<p>A. Lysteda will be approved based on the following criteria:</p> <p>1. History of failure, contraindication, or intolerance to hormonal contraceptive/hormone replacement product</p> <p align="center">-AND-</p> <p>2. Diagnosis with cyclic heavy menstrual bleeding.</p> <p>Authorization will be issued for 12 months.</p>
