Dear UnitedHealthcare Community Plan member,

This notice tells you about benefit changes **beginning October 1, 2016**. One change is a change in your dental services if you are 21 years of age and older. The other is about a change in foot and ankle services.

Beginning October 1, 2016, UnitedHealthcare Community Plan will now cover dental services, including dentures, for **members who are 21 years of age and older**. These dental services are limited to a total amount of \$1,000 for each 12 month period beginning October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017.

There is no change in coverage of dental services for members who are under 21 years of age. For members under the age of 21, UnitedHealthcare Community Plan covers all medically necessary dental services including emergency dental services, dental screening, preventive services, and therapeutic dental services.

Beginning October 1, 2016, UnitedHealthcare Community Plan will cover foot and ankle services performed by a licensed podiatrist, when the service is ordered by a primary care physician or primary care practitioner.
