

## **IMPORTANT UPDATE TO MEDICAID HANDBOOK**

Effective 7/1/18, MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES are available through UnitedHealthcare Community Plan of Ohio.

These services include:

- Medical Services
- Medication-Assisted Treatment for Addiction
- Office Administered Medications
- Psychological Testing
- Mental Health Day Treatment
- Substance Use Disorder Services to include Peer Recovery Support, Partial Hospitalization, and Residential Treatment
- Therapeutic Behavioral Service
- Psychosocial Rehabilitation
- Community Psychiatric Support Services

In addition to these services, two new services are also available: Assertive Community Treatment and Intensive Home Based Treatment.
