Florida Medicaid is submitting a draft statewide transition plan for how we will implement the new Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services' Home and Community Based Settings rule for these Medicaid programs:

- Long-term Care Managed Care Waiver (FL.0962)
- Developmental Disabilities Individual Budgeting Waiver (FL.0867)
- Familial Dysautonomia Waiver (FL.40205)
- Project AIDS Care Waiver (FL.0194)
- Traumatic Brain Injury and Spinal Cord Injury Waiver (FL.0342)
- Adult Cystic Fibrosis Waiver (FL.0392)
- Model Waiver (FL.40166)
- Redirections program (SPA13-013).

The new rule makes sure that waiver recipients get their services from providers who:

- Work with them to create a plan of care;
- Make them feel at home if they live in a group home, assisted living facility, or adult family care home; and
- Help them be part of the community.
