UnitedHealthcare Community Plan's Preferred Drug List (PDL), which is a list of prescription drugs covered by your plan, has been recently updated.

To see which drugs are covered, find your PDL under the Pharmacies and Prescriptions section on myuhc.com. You can call the number on your ID card if you need help.

If you take one of the drugs below, ask your doctor if another drug will work for you. Your doctor may need to write a prescription for the new drug.

If needed, your doctor can ask UnitedHealthcare Community Plan for a prior authorization. If the prior authorization is approved, we will continue to cover this drug.

Brand Name	Generic Name	Comments
Farxiga®	Dapagliflozin tablet	Indicated as an adjunct to diet and exercise to improve glycemic control in adults with type 2 diabetes, to reduce the risk of hospitalization for heart failure in adults with type 2 diabetes and established cardiovascular disease or multiple cardiovascular risk factors, and to reduce the risk of cardiovascular death and hospitalization for heart failure in adults with heart failure with reduced ejection fraction. Prior authorization required.
Nurtec™ ODT	Rimegepant orally disintegrating tablet	Indicated for the acute treatment of migraines. Prior authorization required.
Pataday® OTC	Olopatadine ophthalmic solution 0.1% and 0.2%	Indicated for the treatment of the signs and symptoms of allergic conjunctivitis.
Semglee™	Insulin Glargine Vials, Pens	Indicated to improve glycemic control in adults and pediatric patients with type 1 diabetes mellitus and in adults with type 2 diabetes mellitus.
