## Extras for all adult members

### UnitedHealthcare Healthy Rewards Program\*

Receive a reusable debit card for amounts between \$10 and \$25 to use in retail stores. Members earn rewards for healthy things like immunizations and flu shots. Rewards can be used to purchase health-related items.

### Adult Dental

Any members over age 21 can visit a participating dental provider for exams, x-rays, cleanings and fillings. Covers up to \$500 per year. Dentures are available every 5 years.

### More Rides

Up to 12 rides annually including the grocery store, food banks, pharmacy, prenatal classes, WIC, local community activities and job related activities. Bus passes of up to \$25 per year available for those living in Wyandotte, Johnson, and Sedgwick counties. Must be age 20 and over.



## Extras for those on HCBS waiver

### Home Helper Catalog

Frail Elderly (FE), Physically Disabled (PD) or Intellectual or Developmentally Disabled (I/DD) members can choose one home safety or home assistance product from our catalog through your Care Coordinator. Things like safety rails, personal care or adult briefs are available.

### Pest Control

If you own your own home you are eligible to receive a Pest Control Treatment each year. You must work through your Care Coordinator to set up treatment.

### Mental Health First Aid Certification

Take a 12-hour course and become a certified Mental Health First Aider.

### Parks and Recreation Activity

PD and FE members can have some fun with one free activity up to \$50 per year at a participating local parks and recreation department.



## Extras for those on Frail Elderly (FE) waiver

### Dentures

FE members can get a complete set of dentures every 5 years.

### Wellness Calendar

FE Members receive a calendar at the start of the year to track doctor appointments, medicines and social events.



## Extras for those with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD)

### Respite Care

Members who are receiving the I/DD Waiver Benefits and receiving home services are eligible to receive 40 hours of respite care. You must work through your Care Coordinator.

### Electronic Book

I/DD members and caregivers can download e-book on disabilities.
