

Drug Coverage Changes

Drug coverage will have changes starting October 1, 2020. This change is because of a Michigan Department of Health and Human Services policy change.

If you filled a drug that will no longer be covered, you will get a letter. Your doctor may need to switch you to a different drug or request that you to keep taking drugs that will no longer be covered.

You will be able get the same drug until September 30, 2020

What Should You Do?

If you get a letter, please talk to your doctor about the changes in the letter as soon as possible. The letter may provide other drugs to choose. If your doctor feels that you cannot use another drug, they may request a prior authorization for the drug you are taking. It is important that you follow these steps so you will not have issues getting drugs after October 1, 2020.
