



## Diabetic Supply Changes Effective Jan. 1, 2016

To help provide our members with clinically appropriate, cost-effective diabetic supplies, UnitedHealthcare Community Plan has selected LifeScan (OneTouch<sup>®</sup>) as the preferred manufacturer for diabetic blood glucose meters and test strips.

As of Jan. 1, 2016, only LifeScan (OneTouch) meters and test strips are included on the Preferred Drug List. The LifeScan meters are offered at no cost for members. Other tests strip manufacturers, including Roche (Accu-Chek<sup>®</sup>), are no longer preferred and have been removed from the Preferred Drug List.
